This milestone showcases our commitment to innovation and cutting-edge medical technology in patient care.

The patient presented with a particularly challenging case, having undergone a previous femur fracture repair with indwelling hardware, which made a conventional knee replacement approach unfeasible. Traditional techniques rely on the femoral canal for alignment of the prosthesis - a method that was not viable in this case. Additionally, the patient had a significant 14-degree knee deformity, further complicating the procedure.

## The Role of Robotics in Precision Surgery

Robotic-assisted knee replacements offer significant advantages over conventional techniques by ensuring **unparalleled precision** in prosthetic placement, alignment and soft tissue balancing. The technology removes the margin of error inherent in manual approaches, allowing for **real-time intraoperative adjustments** based on continuous feedback. This enhances both surgical accuracy and long-term patient outcomes.

For this procedure, Dr. Moonda utilised the **Corin Omnibot system,** which is particularly advantageous as it dynamically monitors live tissue

and ligament tension throughout the full range of motion. The incorporation of the **BalanceBot robotic tensioner** enables meticulous balancing of soft tissues, ensuring optimal joint function post-surgery.

"There are several robotic systems available, each with unique execution methods. I have been trained to utilise multiple systems, allowing me to select the most suitable one for each patient's specific needs," says Dr. Moonda.
